Specific commitments	<p>1. As from the day following that of the signing of CEPA, to allow Macao service suppliers to set up joint venture enterprises in the Mainland to provide the following five types of value-added telecommunications services<sup>1</sup>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>(1) internet data centre services;</li> <li>(2) store and forward services;</li> <li>(3) call centre services;</li> <li>(4) internet access services;</li> <li>(5) content services.</li> </ul> <p>2. Macao service suppliers' shareholding in the joint venture enterprises engaging in the value-added telecommunications services mentioned in item 1 above should not exceed 50%.</p> <p>3. There will be no geographic restriction for the joint venture enterprises formed by Macao service suppliers and the Mainland to provide value-added telecommunications services mentioned in item 1 above.</p>

Specific commitments	<p>To allow Macao service suppliers to set up equity joint-venture enterprises in the Mainland, without geographic restriction, to provide internet virtual private network services in the “Telecommunications Business Classification”. Macao service suppliers’ shareholding in the joint venture enterprises should not exceed 50%.</p>
