Specific commitments	<p><u>Videos, sound recording products distribution services</u></p> <p>1. To allow Macao service suppliers to provide, in the form of joint venture, videos and sound recording products (including motion picture products) distribution services in the Mainland.<sup>1</sup></p> <p>2. To allow majority shareholding, not exceeding 70%, for Macao service suppliers.</p>
	<p><u>Cinema theatre services</u></p> <p>1. To allow Macao service suppliers to construct/renovate and operate cinema theatres on an equity joint venture or contractual joint venture basis.</p> <p>2. To allow majority shareholding, not exceeding 75%, for Macao service suppliers.</p>

<sup>1</sup> In undertaking distribution services in the Mainland in respect of videos and sound recording products, Macao service suppliers should comply with the relevant laws, regulations and requirements of the review system in the Mainland.

	<p><u>Chinese language motion pictures and motion pictures jointly produced</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Chinese language motion pictures produced in Macao may be imported for distribution in the Mainland on a quota-free basis, after vetting and approval by the relevant Mainland authority.</li><li>2. Chinese language motion pictures produced in Macao refer to those motion pictures made by production companies which are set up or established in accordance with the relevant laws of the Macao Special Administrative Region, and which own more than 75% of the copyright of the motion pictures concerned. Macao residents should comprise more than 50% of the total principal personnel<sup>2</sup> in the motion pictures concerned.</li><li>3. Motion pictures jointly produced by Macao and the Mainland are treated as Mainland motion pictures for the purpose of distribution in the Mainland. Translated versions of the motion pictures in languages of other Chinese ethnic groups and Chinese dialects, which are based on the Putonghua version, are allowed to be distributed in the Mainland.</li><li>4. For motion pictures jointly produced by Macao and the Mainland, there is no restriction on the percentage of principal creative personnel<sup>3</sup> from Macao, but at least one-third of the leading artists must be from the Mainland; there is no restriction on where the story takes place, but the plots or the leading characters must be related to the Mainland.</li></ol>

<sup>2</sup> Principal personnel includes personnel performing the roles of director, screenwriter, leading actor, leading actress, supporting actor, supporting actress, producer, cinematographer, editor, art director, costume designer, action choreographer, and composer of the original film score.

<sup>3</sup> Major creative personnel refers to personnel performing the roles of director, screenwriter, cinematographer and leading artists. Leading artists refer to leading actor, leading actress, leading supporting actor and leading supporting actress.

To allow motion pictures co-produced by the Mainland and Macao to be processed outside the Mainland after obtaining the approval of the relevant authorities in the Mainland.</p> <p>2. To allow Macao service suppliers to establish wholly-owned companies in pilot areas in the Mainland to engage in distribution of Mainland produced motion pictures after obtaining the approval of the relevant authorities in the Mainland.</p>

	<p><u>Technical service of cable television</u></p> <p>To allow Macao companies engaging in the operation of cable television network to provide professional technical services for cable television networks in pilot areas of the Guangdong Province after obtaining the approval of the relevant authorities in the Mainland.</p>
	<p><u>Television drama jointly produced</u></p> <p>Television drama co-produced by the Mainland and Macao are permitted to be broadcast and distributed in the same way as Mainland produced television drama after being examined by the relevant authorities in the Mainland.</p>

Specific commitments	<p><u>Cinema theatre services</u></p> <p>Macao service suppliers are permitted to establish wholly-owned companies in the Mainland, each of which may construct or renovate more than one cinema theatre at more than one location for the operation of film screening business.</p>

	<p><u>Chinese language motion pictures and motion pictures jointly produced</u></p> <p>1. The Cantonese version of motion pictures co-produced by Macao and the Mainland is permitted to be distributed and screened in Guangdong Province, after obtaining the approval of the relevant authorities in the Mainland; the Cantonese version of motion pictures produced by Macao and solely imported by the Film Import and Export Corporation of the China Film Group Corporation is permitted to be distributed and screened in Guangdong Province, after being examined by and obtaining the approval of the relevant authorities in the Mainland.</p> <p>2. The import of Chinese language motion pictures made by production companies which are set up in accordance with the relevant laws of the Macao Special Administrative Region and which own more than 50% of the copyright of the motion pictures concerned<sup>4</sup> is exempted from quota restrictions for distribution in the Mainland, after being examined by and obtaining the approval of the relevant authorities in the Mainland.</p> <p><u>Jointly produced television dramas</u></p> <p>Television dramas co-produced by the Mainland and Macao should be subject to the same standard on the number of episodes as that applicable to Mainland domestically-produced television dramas.</p>

<sup>4</sup> Macao residents should comprise more than 50% of the total principal personnel in the motion pictures concerned. Principal personnel includes personnel performing the roles of director, screenwriter, leading actor, leading actress, supporting actor, supporting actress, producer, cinematographer, editor, art director, costume designer, action choreographer, and composer of the original film score.

	Chinese language motion pictures and motion pictures jointly produced  To allow the principal production unit of Mainland motion pictures (including motion pictures jointly produced) to apply for and carry out post-production in Macao after authorized by the State Administration of Radio, Film and Television.
