To allow Macao service suppliers to set up internet culture business units and internet online service premises in the Mainland with the Mainland party holding majority shares. 5. To allow Macao service suppliers to set up art galleries, art shops and art work exhibition units in the Mainland on an equity joint venture, contractual joint venture or wholly-owned basis.

Specific commitments	<p>1. To allow Macao service suppliers to set up wholly-owned performance agencies in the Mainland.</p> <p>2. To allow Macao performance agencies or performing arts groups, in the cross-border mode of supply, to organize commercial performances in the Guangdong Province and the Shanghai Municipality on a pilot basis, after obtaining the approval of the relevant authorities of that Province or Municipality. The performance agencies or performing arts groups organizing in the Mainland should obtain approval of the Ministry of Culture.</p>
