	Individually owned stores
Specific commitments	<p>To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government in the Mainland, without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments. The scope of business for individually owned stores, excluding franchising, includes retailing services, food and beverage services, as well as hair dressing services, beauty and health treatment services, bathing services, repair services for household electric appliances and goods for daily uses under the category of residents services and other services. The number of employees for each store shall not exceed 8 persons and the business area shall not exceed 300 square metres.</p>

	Individually owned stores
Specific commitments	<p>To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government in the Mainland without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments, to provide the following four kinds of services (excluding franchising operation): import and export of goods and technologies; photography and photographic processing services; washing, cleaning and dyeing services; and repair and maintenance of motor vehicles and motorcycles. No more than 8 persons should be engaged in the operation of the individually owned stores, and the business area of such stores should not exceed 300 square meters.</p>

Specific commitments	<p>To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government in the Mainland without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments, to provide the following services (excluding franchising): cultivation; animal husbandry; aquaculture; computer repair services; technology exchange and promotion services. The number of employees for each store shall not exceed 8 persons.</p>

Specific commitments	<p>To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government in the Mainland, without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments. The number of employees for each store shall not exceed 8 persons. The scope of business for individually owned stores, excluding franchising, includes: computer services, software services; loading/unloading and portorage services related to road transport, other transport services¹, storage and warehousing services²; translation and interpretation services³.</p>

¹ Excluding international freight forwarding agency and courier services.

² The business area for storage and warehousing services should not exceed 300 square meters.

³ Confined to business activities only.

Specific commitments	<p>1. To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government in the Mainland, without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments. The number of employees for each store shall not exceed 8 persons. The scope of business for individually owned stores, excluding franchising, includes: building-cleaning services; advertising production services.</p> <p>2. To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in the Guangdong Province, without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments. The number of employees for each store shall not exceed 8 persons. The scope of business for individually owned stores, excluding franchising, includes: trade brokerage and agency services (excluding auction); renting and leasing services (excluding renting and leasing of housing services).</p>

Specific commitments	<p>1. To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government in the Mainland, without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments. The number of employees for each store shall not exceed 8 persons. The scope of business for individually owned stores, excluding franchising, includes: individually owned clinic, economic and trade consulting, and business administration consulting services, wholesaling (for textiles, apparel, daily supplies, stationery, sports goods, and other cultural products only).</p>

	Individually owned stores
Specific commitments	<p>To allow Macao permanent residents with Chinese citizenship to set up, in accordance with the relevant Mainland laws, regulations and administrative regulations, individually owned stores in all provinces, autonomous regions, municipalities directly under the Central Government in the Mainland, without being subject to the approval procedures applicable to foreign investments, excluding franchising operation, and no more than 8 persons should be engaged in the operation of the individually owned stores. The scope of business includes: marriage services under residents services (excluding matchmaking services), renting and leasing services of comic books and electronic animation game products, renting and leasing services of animation audio-video products^①, as well as veterinary services: pet clinics (to be operated in cities only)^②.</p>

^② Applicant must hold a “License for Diagnosis and Treatment of Animals” for applying business registration.
